October	01	First Official eligibility grade check for all students.
October	08	Students may gain or lose eligibility at the close of the school day.
October	15	Official grade check for all students. The end of the nine-week grading period.
October	22	Students may gain or lose eligibility at the close of the school day.
November	05	Three-week grade check.
November	12	Students may gain eligibility at the close of the school day.
November	19	All students passing or failing are eligible from the close of school Nov. 19, 2010, through the beginning of school Nov. 29, 2010.
December	03	Three-week grade check.
December	10	Students may gain eligibility at the close of the school day.
December	17	Official grade check for all students. The end of the nine-week grading period.
December	17	All students passing or failing are eligible from the close of school Dec. 17, 2010, through the beginning of school on Jan. 5, 2011.
January	12	Students may gain or lose eligibility at the close of the school day.
January	24	Three-week grade check.
January	31	Ineligible students may gain eligibility at the close of the school day.
February	14	Three-week grade check.
February	21	Ineligible students may gain eligibility at the close of the school day.
March	11	Official grade check for all students. The end of the nine-week grading period.
March	11	All students passing or failing are eligible from the close of school on March 11, 2011, through the beginning of school on March 21, 2011.
March	28	Students may gain or lose eligibility at the close of the school day.
April	08	Three-week grade check
April	15	Ineligible students may gain eligibility at the close of the school day
April	29	Three-week grade check.
May	06	Ineligible students may gain eligibility at the close of the school day
June	02	End of the fourth nine-weeks grading period.
