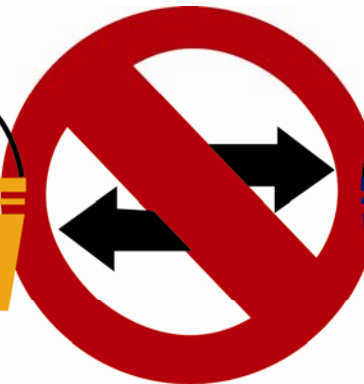




Funding Sources for Clear Creek ISD

2004 Bond
\$1,207.72 per student



2013 Bond
\$1,136.36 per student

- Improve wireless access in every classroom
- Projector, interactive device and document camera per classroom
- Currently 1 computer for more than 3 students
- 2 tablet computers for the cost of 1 laptop
- Initial investment for tablet computers in grades 4 – 12, to be phased in over three years
- Maintenance and replacements through general fund



*Property Tax Increase of \$0.1125
To Be Gradually Phased in*

- \$5.12 initial increase per month
- Maximum annual impact of \$172.72
- Total CCISD tax rate \$1.4725
- Less than CCISD tax rate in 2005
- No impact for 65 years and older

** Tax impact based on CCISD median home of \$177,400*
