

CCI Dress Code 2015-2016

Appropriate clothing worn at school must be in good repair: no holes or fraying, hemmed, may not touch the ground, and must be worn properly at the waist.

Inappropriate clothing not to be worn at school includes, but is not limited to: cut-offs, halters, strapless garments, spaghetti straps, open underarm shirts, tank tops, cleavage midriff, and clothes that expose undershirts, pajamas, sweat pants, boxer shorts, athletic shorts, overalls, overalls, wind or jogging pants, sweat pants, pajamas, stretch pants, yoga pants or leggings or jeggings.

Tops

- Shirts are to be collared, polo style, and must be a solid color –logos no larger than 2” by 2”
- **CCI Spirit T-Shirts may be worn any day of the week** (recognizing a CCI school group, CCI activity, approved by CCI administration - *No alterations are permitted*)
- Inappropriate tops include, but are not limited to, exposure of undershirt, midriff, cleavage, or underarms. **-No sleeveless garments.**

Bottoms

- Pants/Jeans must be in good repair: **no holes or fraying**, hemmed, may not touch the ground and must be worn properly at the waist
- Pants/Jeans are to be one solid color: navy blue, black, or khaki. No Leather, suede, vinyl, nylon, spandex, knit or shiny material
- Inappropriate bottoms include, but are not limited to, overalls, coveralls, wind or jogging pants, sweat pants, pajamas, stretch pants, yoga pants, leggings or jeggings.
- Shorts, skirts, dresses, skorts must be solid in color (Navy Blue, Black or Khaki only) and have a hem that must be knee length when kneeling (1” from floor). **No athletic or gym shorts**

Outerwear/Sweatshirts

- Heavy jackets, coats, and/or out of dress code outerwear worn to school must be placed in locker before arrival to the first class and must remain stored until dismissed
- Sweatshirts and hoodies worn during the school day can be pullover or zip-up with crew neck or hoodie type, cotton or fleece fabric only must be banded at the waist and wrist and be a **solid color**.
- Outerwear logos other than CCI, may not be larger than 2” by 2”
- These items of clothing may not be worn tied around the waist

Jewelry/ Related Items

- Pierced jewelry is limited to ears only
- No inappropriate collars, bracelets or wrist bands (leather, spiked or other sharp edges or inappropriate words)
- No hats or head coverings permitted (unless exempt for religious beliefs and approved by administration)
- Unnatural hair color or unusual hair styles (Mohawks or faux hawks more than ½” high, distracting markings carved in hair etc.) are not permitted
- No sunglasses will be allowed to be worn on campus

Backpacks/purses

- **Students will be allowed to wear String Backpacks for the 2015-16 school year.**
- Large backpacks including rolling backpacks, satchels, large purses, and other large storage devices must be placed in locker before arrival to the first class and must remain stored until dismissed
- In order to carry a purse at school it may be no larger than **8 1/2” by 11”**

Shoes

- Shoes with lacing holes must have laces present and tied
- Heels may not be higher than 2”
- No house slippers, athletic sandals, flip-flops, rubber sandals or Heelies
- **All shoes must have a back or heel strap**

* The Principals shall determine if clothing, jewelry or hair is appropriate for school

* Any piece of clothing, jewelry, or hair style deemed an educational distraction by the Principals will not be allowed

* Please contact an administrator if there are any questions regarding hair styles, haircuts or clothing prior to buying or getting hair done

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Free Dress Days

The principal may announce that a day is a free dress day and the following dress code will apply

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- No shower shoes, house slippers, athletic sandals, flip-flops, rubber sandals or Heelies
- All shoes must have a back or heel strap
- Any garment, regardless of what it is called, must be worn no shorter than knee length when kneeling (1" from floor)
- Skirts and dresses must come to than knee length when kneeling (1" from floor)
- Pants or shorts shall be appropriately sized and worn at the natural waistline.
- Clothes, jewelry, and other accessories that contain suggestive, inappropriate, or vulgar slogans or images, or advertise illegal products, alcohol and/or tobacco are prohibited.
- Spiked and/or leather accessories and/or chains are not permitted (wallets, etc.)
- Any type of garment that can be interpreted as gang-related is not allowed on campus during school hours or at any school-related activity.
- Hats, caps, headbands, or any other types of head covering garments are not allowed on campus during school hours.
- Sunglasses may not be worn in the building.
- Clothing/hair styles, which in the judgment of the building administrators, pose a health or safety hazard and/or disrupt the educational process are not permitted.

* The Principals shall determine if clothing, jewelry or hair is appropriate for school

* Any piece of clothing, jewelry, or hair style deemed an educational distraction by the Principals will not be allowed

* All other general requirements of the CCISD dress code policy apply

The building administrators determine whether a student's dress is appropriate and issue consequences. Repeated offenses may result in more serious disciplinary action. Appropriate discipline procedures shall be followed in all cases.
