

Clear Path Alternative School: Dress Code

Uniform Dress Code

The following uniform dress code is to be followed by students at all times. Students not properly dressed at the beginning of the day will not be allowed to enter the building. Students found out of dress code while on campus will have points taken off their behavior sheet.

All students shall wear the designated uniform.

- Black, tan or navy blue-colored school uniform style pants. Pants must be properly sized, belted at the waist, with belt loops, and in good repair. Pants may not be worn over-sized or baggy. No cargo pants, no Capri style, or pants with additional pockets on the legs are allowed. No shorts are allowed. No corduroy or jeans material allowed. No pants with pockets that can not be pulled out.
- Student shirt requirements change with their level. Students on levels one, two, and three must wear all-white button down dress shirts, long or short sleeved. Shirts must have a functioning top button. Shirts must be tucked in the pants without any "blousing" and should be neat in appearance. Shirts that are too short to be tucked in will not be allowed. Short sleeves may be worn provided no tattoos or other markings are visible. No logos on shirts are allowed. Students on level four may wear a long or short-sleeved, polo-style shirt, plain without any emblems, in the solid colors of white, black, navy blue, green, or red.
- Students on levels zero, one and two will be required to wear a school-provided tie while on campus.
- 1" – 2" Black or brown traditional belt with traditional buckle. There should be no decorations and/or perforations.
- Solid black or white tennis, athletic or Van styled shoes only. Shoelaces will be white or black to match the shoe, no other color is acceptable.
- No tattoos, writing, or markings of any kind may be visible. Tattoos that can not be covered by clothing must be covered with bandages PRIOR to arriving on campus.
- Hats, caps, bandanas, and other head apparel may not be worn and are not permitted, and no "scrunchies" will be allowed. No hair clips or pins of any type are allowed.
- Absolutely no jewelry is permitted. This includes watches, earrings, rings, or pierced objects, etc. Any jewelry brought to Clear Path will be confiscated and not returned until the end of the student's assignment. No band-aids or other materials may be used to cover up jewelry.

- Hair must be kept clean, conventionally styled and non-distracting. Hair must be cut or pulled back out of the student's face.
- Book bags and backpacks shall not be brought to Clear Path. No purses or wallets are allowed on campus. These will be taken up by staff and subjected to searches.
- Facial hair is not permitted. Boys must be clean-shaven each morning. Students not in compliance will be asked to shave. Points will be deducted for not shaving before arrival at school.
- Students should wear a plain, white-only t-shirt or undershirt under their uniform shirt.
- Jackets and coats are to be placed in a designated place upon arrival and may not be removed until the end of the school day. Jackets with inappropriate advertisements, logos, etc., are not to be worn. During the wintertime, only solid white, black, or gray pullover sweatshirts with no hood or pockets may be worn in the classroom. These items must be worn properly, and worn all day. Sweaters are not acceptable.
